1. Apologies - none

2. Minutes of the last meeting

Were checked by all councillors and accepted as correct and signed.

3. Declarations of interest - none

4. Items for discussion from the floor

The recipients of the cards (Tony's bereavement and Ceri's injury) both gave their thanks to the Council.

There were no other comments.

5. Greenbelt update

The planning permission was granted by Coventry City Council. The meeting was well attended and many spoke against the idea of building on the Greenbelt, including Cllr Camwell and Cllr Milner.

Dorothy (and others) have written to have the Planning Permission 'called in' but it will not be 'called in' for a while.

Objectors must put their case together and ask Stephen McNaught for advice. CPRE has already writtenn to the government about this.

Sylvia and Walter attended a meeting at Rugby when they produced a SLA. A standard SLA has been produced and authorities must follow it's format, so Coventry City Council will need to do another SLA which will delay things and rest the dates.

Houses in areas of subsidence will need under pinning and developers will need to take drainage action because of the current flooding which could get worse.
