Accessibility

This is becoming increasingly important in the field of web design. Legislation (notably The Disabilities Discrimination Act 1995) has been passed to strongly encourage web designers to make websites accessible for web users with disabilities.

This defines requirements for designers and developers to improve accessibility for people with disabilities.

- CSS (cascading style sheets)
- JavaScript
